Discipline Procedure

Methods of Discipline

Children will have a clear understanding of the rules of the child care program. Children will be helped to understand their responsibility to the other children, staff and environment.

The staff will model expected behavior. When negative behavior occurs the staff will attempt to redirect the child's behavior, while praising the positive. If a child's behavior remains disruptive, the parent will be notified of the behavior and the disciplinary procedure will be enacted.
