

# Covid-19 Related Behavior Protocols for Students

Hastings Community Education's Camp Horizons/Big Shots childcare will be open in compliance with State and Federal guidelines during this global pandemic and public health emergency. Please be advised that participant compliance with programming expectations for hygiene, health and safety must be followed.

Community Education programs will take an abundance of care for all children. However, even with caution and preventative measures, an inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public setting where people from different households are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can be transmitted even by people who are asymptomatic and can lead to serious illness and death. By participating in Camp Horizons/Big Shots, users voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure of COVID-19.

## Behavior Protocols for Students:

In light of the current public health crisis, additional behaviors that directly or indirectly threaten the safety of others will not be permitted.

- Spitting
- Inability to follow to social distancing rules
- Intentional actions that cause a health and/or sanitary risk to others

The failure to comply with directives or rules related to these additional behaviors will result in similar consequences, including, but not limited to removal from the program, when other rules of conduct are violated
