### Distance Learning Tips:

**-Go over schoolwork packets or Seesaw lessons before sending children and work to childcare—read the directions and if it's something new, do a few of the problems together. If you don't understand the directions, please don't assume Kids' Campus staff will. Instead, email the teacher and clarify directions.**

**-Write a to-do list and reminders in your child's notebook for the day. Date the pages, make them specific—group leaders love being able to check back on those and encourage students to do the work their parents are encouraging them to do.**

**-Send supplies—make sure your student supply bag is stocked with multiple sharpened pencils and everything they'll need to do their work. We try to supplement with the supplies we have on hand, but having their supplies means they won't have to wait for staff to have to request a glue stick or highlighter brought from another room.**

**-Headphones--NOT earbuds. Make sure your student is ready to connect quietly to those class connects.**

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**-Tech, Zoom, Seesaw—as these things come up, your child’s notebook is more important than ever. Write your child’s zoom times and information in the front of their notebook. Staff will check and make a list for the day. We’ll do our best to get all students to all of their zooms. Make sure all tech is charged and ready for the day before sending.**

**-Check schoolwork every evening and make sure the work they are doing matches your expectations.**
